### THIS WEEK'S LESSON: STRAIGHT FROM THE FISH'S MOUTH



#### IN THE CAR:

Ask your child what they learned about this week on the drive home:  
When Jesus was accused of not paying the temple tax, he found a clever – and gross – way to silence his accusers: producing money inside a fish's mouth. Jesus provides for us each day in many different ways. Matthew 17:24-27, The Temple Tax



#### HANGING OUT:

Make this week's lesson real:  
Share a time when God provided for you in an unexpected way with your kids. Ask them what needs they might have right now, and say a prayer with them for God to provide.



#### AT DINNER:

Here are some great discussion starters:

- How did Jesus know what Peter was going to ask before he asked it?
- How did Jesus provide the coin for Himself and for Peter?
- What should we do when we need something from the Lord?



#### AT BEDTIME:

Quiz your child on this week's memory verse:  
*"Lord, you are great. You are really worthy of praise. No one can completely understand how great you are." Psalm 145:3 (NirV)*



#### PARENT TIME:

What you need to know: God knows our needs before we ask, but He still wants us to ask. He may not answer in a way we expect, and He may ask us to take action as well, but He will provide. Thank God for His provision, and pray fervently for your children's current needs this week.
