THIS WEEK'S LESSON: FISH FOOD



IN THE CAR:

Ask your child what they learned about this week on the drive home:

God asked Jonah to go to the city of Nineveh and tell the people to repent of their evil ways and turn to God. Jonah didn't want to so he hopped on a boat going the opposite direction from Nineveh. God used a big storm and a stinky fish's belly to give Jonah a second chance to make a right choice. Jonah 1-2:1, and 2:10, Jonah Runs from God



HANGING OUT:

Make this week's lesson real:

Is there a recipe someone tried and failed in your house? A project someone started but never completed? Why not give something or someone in your house a second chance this week?



AT DINNER:

Here are some great discussion starters:

- How did God give Jonah a second chance?
- Why is it good that God gives second chances?
- Will God always give us another chance when we ask?



AT BEDTIME:

Quiz your child on this week's memory verse:

"Lord, you are great. You are really worthy of praise. No one can completely understand how great you are." Psalm 145:3 (NIV)



PARENT TIME:

What you need to know: God's love is amazing. He is always forgiving when we ask. If you have messed up and need a do-over, ask God to give you another chance this week. Pray that God will use you to model forgiveness to your kids as He forgives you.
